- Copy of photo ID or Driver's License.
- Unofficial copy of your transcript that reflects your current cumulative GPA. GPA must be 2.5 and above (unweighted).
- Acceptance letter from an accredited 2 or 4 year college or university that you plan to attend.*
- Photograph of yourself (school photo, etc.). You may send a senior picture. NOTE: The picture will be printed in the scholarship souvenir book and will not be returned.
- Application must contain Guidance Counselor's name and the school's telephone number.
- Please do not leave any lines or questions unanswered on the application.
- Do not alter the application. NOTE: Altered applications will automatically be disqualified.
- Two letters of recommendation from individuals knowledgeable of your personal attributes and involvement in extracurricular/community activities (parents and relatives excluded).
- If selected, you must attend the Scholarship Awards Ceremony Presentation. The value of the scholarship award is \$1,000.00.

*Individuals may be selected to receive a scholarship after applying, but prior to being accepted to a 2 or 4 year institution. However, your scholarship will not be issued and distributed until your acceptance has been granted and verified in writing.
